

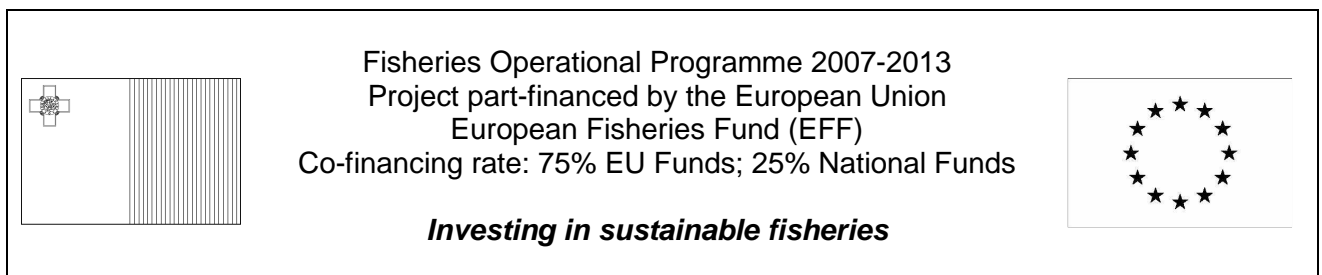
European Fisheries Fund 2007 – 2013 (EFF) Technical Assistance Criteria

EFF Technical Assistance supports a number of actions including:

- Increasing and improving the administrative capacity for the implementation and the management of the OP.
- Actions relating to the administration, management, monitoring, audit and control of the OP.
- Actions relating to publicity and dissemination of information on the implementation of the OP.
- Actions relating to information and publicity obligations of the OP.
- Actions related to evaluations, expert reports, statistics and studies supporting the implementation of the OP.

Each request must fulfil the following criteria in order to be considered eligible for Technical Assistance Funding:

- A complete request for approval form must be presented and should be filled in with all relevant details and documentation (including estimates, full details of items/services requested and proposed procurement procedure).
- For all requests for capacity building, the Applicant must provide a description so as to highlight that the event to be attended is clearly linked to his/her role in the implementation of the EFF and/or EMFF.¹
- The request must be in line with one of the components outlined above.
- The applicant must be the Managing Authority, the MRRA, the Certifying Authority, the Audit Authority as well as any other horizontal stakeholder in the implementation system.



¹ The component Capacity Building includes, amongst others, training, participation in conferences and meetings including technical meetings, as well as network activities.
