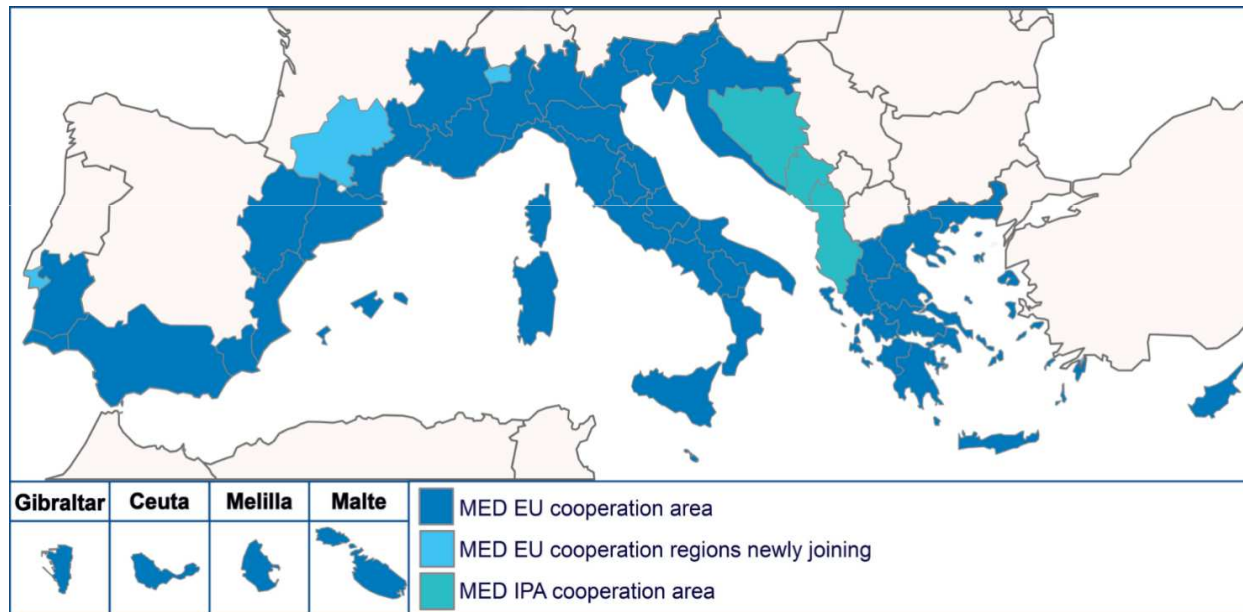

Overall Objective

The overall objective of the MED programme is to **promote sustainable growth** in the Mediterranean area by **fostering innovative concepts** and practices (technologies, governance, innovative services...), **reasonable use of resources** (energy, water, maritime resources...) and **supporting social integration** through integrated and territorially based cooperation approach

Interreg MED cooperation area

13 States: 10 EU Member States + 3 IPA States (Albania, Bosnia and Herzogovina, Montenegro)

Total contribution: €233,678,308 of which

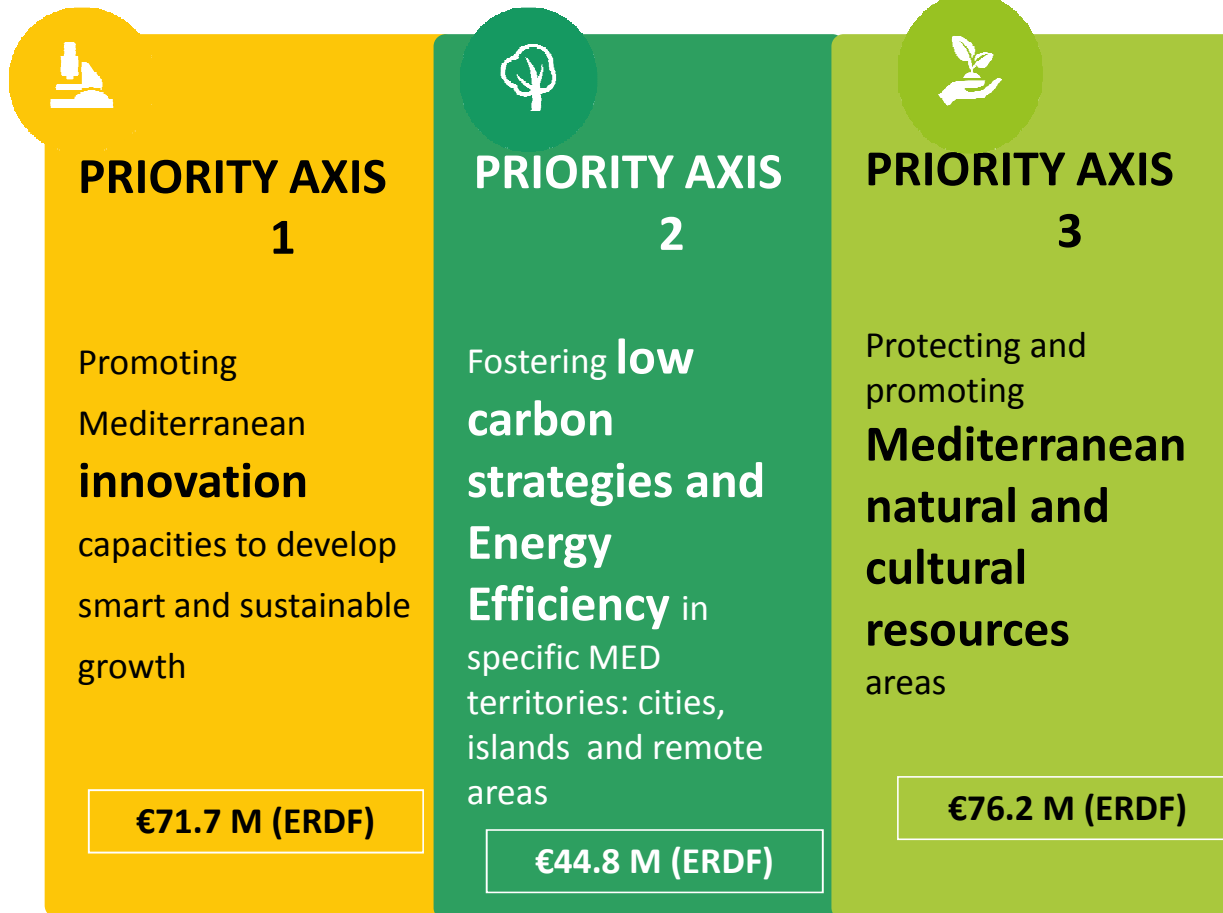
ERDF - €224,322,525 million **IPA - €9,355,783 million**

Co-financing rates for ERDF Partners (*also for SMEs applying the 'de minimis' regulation on State Aid*):

85% ERDF - 15% national

Co-financing rates for Private ERDF Partners *concerned by State Aid and applying the 'General Block Exemption Regulation' (GBER)*:

50% ERDF - 50% own funding

Conditions

Project activities should take place in the MED area

1 Lead Partner + **multiple** financing Partners (+ Associate Partner/s if required)

Financing Partners:

- ❖ **minimum 4**
- ❖ **from at least 4 different countries** (from the Interreg MED Programme area)
- ❖ **at least 3 partners of which are located in the EU part of the Interreg MED Programme area**

The size of the partnership should reflect the scope of the project and remain manageable.

Lead Partner	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. public body or body governed by public law (private institutions, international organisations and IPA partners cannot be Lead Partners)2. physically based in the Union part of the Interreg MED Programme area
Financing Partners	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. national, regional and local public bodies2. public equivalent bodies, i.e. bodies governed by public law3. private bodies, NGOs, voluntary organisations4. international organisations acting under the national law of any EU MED Member State or, with restrictions, under international law

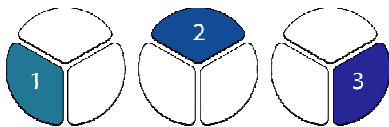
Project type: The 'Modular' approach

The modules :

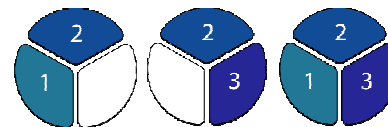
- ↻ **Module 1: STUDYING: designing common approaches & strategies at TN**

September – November 2015: modular call

Call budget: €75M

November 2015 – January 2016: horizontal call

Budget: €9M

January – March 2017: modular call ('Integrated' and 'Single Modules')

Budget: €65M

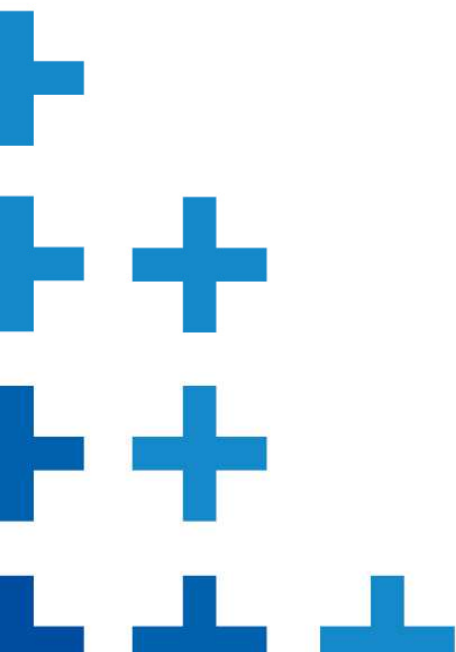
