

## Med Programme – 2<sup>nd</sup> Call for Proposals

The 2<sup>nd</sup> Call for project proposals under the Med Programme has been launched on 16 February 2009 and will close on 13 March 2009. All those interested in participating in this programme are advised to consult the relevant parts of the Med Programme's website <http://www.programmemed.eu/> in particular, the latest news section

Maltese entities should be aware that the application form is first filled online through: <http://med.presage-cte.org/>. It is recommended that partners follow the various instructions provided in the Project Space section: <http://www.programmemed.eu/index.php?id=5228&L=1>. Due attention must be given to the necessary documentation required for submitting an application, namely, the Application Pack, Support Documents and the Presage Visual Guide. Furthermore, interested parties should also be aware of the thresholds set at a national level. Particular attention should be given to the threshold with regard to internal staff costs (35%) and to the fact that indirect overhead costs are not eligible under this call. Applicants should also liaise with PPCD before budgeting for any PCs/ laptops.

At this stage, it is also possible to submit a project idea to the Joint Technical Secretariat for preliminary feedback.

Furthermore, the Territorial Cooperation Unit, PPCD shall be allocating two days on 23-24 February for individual meetings, by appointment, with potential Maltese partners. Prior to such a meeting it is recommended that partners provide a project idea as well as the details of the contact persons concerned.
